

Avalon Wolves Community:

We appreciate your interest in our program, and are working toward a fantastic upcoming season. Our community and football/cheer program are growing at a rapid pace. Given this growth, we are working on trying to accommodate as many players/families as possible. In order to streamline responses to similar questions please review the following list of frequently asked questions, (categorized by preseason and in season subjects):

Preseason FAQ's

1. **When is registration this year?** Answer: To Be Announced.
2. **What do we need to bring to registration?** Answer: Proof of residency, a registration form and a checkbook.
3. **How much does it cost?** Answer: \$175 total, if your son/daughter is placed on a roster you will need to pay a \$125 deposit at registration. If you are placed on a waiting list, no deposit is required. The balance of \$50 is due at equipment in June/July. Flag football cost \$90 for the season.
4. **When do we need physical forms completed?** Answer: The original Pop Warner physical form will be required at equipment pick-up in June/July in order to receive your equipment. Physicals must have been performed in 2008.
5. **Who signs up at registration?** Answer: All participants are required to sign up during the one registration event, tackle football, cheerleading and flag football. There may be an additional flag registration day. Please check this website for an additional time and day.
6. **Can I sign up early or late?** Answer: Due to demand, you must be present at registration to sign up. If there are extenuating circumstances, you may have a friend or relative deliver your information during registration. All new registration applicants are required to wait in line. Pre-registered applicants from the previous season are required to weigh in and make a payment. If you are submitting information after registration, you will be placed on a waiting list.
7. **When is equipment pick up?** Answer: You will be notified by mail and the website will have the date/location posted. Generally the date is in June/July. *You may not pick up equipment early.* If you have a conflict your head coach will have an alternate date and location for equipment pick up during the first week of practice.
8. **What is the cut off for league age?** Answer: All league age is determined by the actual age of your child on July 31 of the year in which he/she will participate.
9. **What are the age/weight requirements for tackle football?** Answer:
 - **Tiny-Mite-** 6-7 yrs., 35 to 75 lbs., end of season max = 84 lbs.

 - **Mitey-Mite-** 8-9 yrs., 45-90 lbs., end of season max = 99 lbs.
 -
 - **Jr. PeeWee-** 9-10 yrs., 60-105 lbs., end of season max = 114 lbs.
11 yrs., 60-85 lbs., end of season max = 94 lbs.
 - **PeeWee-** 10-11 yrs., 75-120 lbs., end of season max = 129 lbs.
12 yrs., 75-100 lbs., end of season max = 109 lbs.
 - **Jr. Midget-** 11-12 yrs., 85-135 lbs., end of season max = 144 lbs.
13 yrs., 85-115 lbs., end of season max = 124 lbs.
 - **Midget-** 12-13-14 yrs., 110-160 lbs., end of season max = 169 lbs.
15 yrs., 105-140 lbs., end of season max = 149 lbs.

10. **What are the age/weight requirements for flag football?** Answer:
- 6-7-8 yrs., no weight limit
 - 9-10-11 yrs., no weight limit
11. **Can I help Coach?** Answer: We interview our head coaches months before the season starts and are selected based on several different criteria. Each head coach has the responsibility to choose his/her own assistant coaches. If you are interested in an assistant coach position, please send an email to the listed head coach, (on this website) for the respective division. If you would like to be considered as a head coach for the following season, you will need to fill out a volunteer form at the end of this coming season.
12. **Where do we practice?** Answer: All practices take place at Timber Creek High School, next to the football field. You can expect three practices per week and a game on Saturday. (There will be practice or scrimmage on Saturdays until season starts).
13. **When is the first practice?** Answer: August 1.
14. **How long is the season?** Answer: The regular season runs from August 1 through the end of October. (Jr. Pee Wee through Midgets can go longer depending on how they do in competition). There are usually ten games and one pre-season jamboree, (possible bowl game or playoffs).
15. **Where are games played?** Answer: Home games are played at Timber Creek High School. Away games are played at different Pop Warner sites, usually a high school in the Central Florida area.
16. **Are there certifications required to volunteer for a position with the league?** Answer: Yes, all coaches attend a certification class conducted by our governing body, Mid Florida Pop Warner. Parents who volunteer and are on the field and any other volunteers need to fill out a background check application.
17. **I missed registration, how can I get registered?** Answer: Due to high demand you will most likely be placed on a waiting list. Please go to avalonwolves.com, print and fill out the registration form at the bottom. Then mail the form to the address listed on the website. If you are new to the program, please include proof of residency. You will not need to send in a deposit at this time. Several changes happen between registration and the beginning of the season. If your child is placed on a roster you will be informed as soon as possible, or by the middle of July. If not, we will waive your child, so that you can register in another local Pop Warner program. *Another option is to sign your child up for flag football this season and pre-register for the waiting list at the end of this season for next year.*
18. **When will there be another registration day?** Answer: There is only one registration day for tackle football, (usually in May). Flag will usually have two registration days, one during tackle registration and another within the first few weeks of August. Please keep checking the website for dates and times.
19. **Are there off-season programs to prepare my child for the upcoming season?** Answer: By rule, Pop Warner does not allow off-season programs to be run by our program. We do advertise for programs that we feel might benefit your child. We update our website frequently, so you can find the latest information at avalonwolves.com.
20. **When is equipment pick up day?** Answer: Usually late June to Mid July. You will receive a schedule in the mail, which will list a time for your division.
21. **What if we are relocating to the Timber Creek/East Orlando area and want to participate?** Answer: If your child participated in another Pop Warner program you will be given priority, provided there are roster spots for their respective division. We will need proof of residency before we can actively place your child on a roster.
